




Restructuring





Notable Deals & Transactions

- Our firm represents **Vodafone Egypt** in its acquisition of a stake in the subsidiaries Ebtikar Holding for Financial Services S.A.E, a company focused on nonbanking financial services. We advise Vodafone on the legal and regulatory updates in the sector and support them in their negotiation with the relevant authorities, including the Central Bank of Egypt, to obtain the required approvals for the sought acquisition.
- The firm acted as local counsel for **Majorel**, a leading global provider of next-generation end-to-end customer experience (CX) solutions for digital-native and vertical leading brands, on its potential acquisition of IST Networks ('IST''), a leading full-service CX Technology Services provider. DLA Piper Netherlands acted as international counsel for the transaction.
- Our team represented **Alturki Holding inc** its sale of 100% of their shares in the electronics retail Itisalat International (i2) and United Retail Company (URC) to Raya Distribution a subsidiary of Raya Holding.

- Our team represented **East Gas** in the deal involving a joint venture composed of local and international companies in the acquisition of a 39% stake in the submarine pipeline owner "East Mediterranean Gas Co. This settlement caused the activation of the idle subsea pipeline owned by the East Mediterranean Gas Co. (Egypt) connecting between Sheikh Zuweid and Ashkelon.
- Represented Vodafone Egypt in the annulment of 800 million arbitral award rendered in favor of Etisalat Egypt under the auspices of CRCICA in the remarkable settlement amassing all four operators of mobile services in Egypt and the NTRA in ten years of disputes concerning the applicability of interconnection rates between the operators, were squashed and withdrawn. The settlement agreement has also set a new norm for re-fixing the interconnection rates under the patronage of the Egyptian Ministry of Communication and Information Technology and the NTRA. The settlement's approx. value EGP 2 billion.
